Ryan is an Emmy® Award-winning Creative Professional who has made an unexpected impact in the pro-life movement with the bold TooManyAborted.com billboard/web campaign. The initiative caused a media frenzy with massive coverage from The New York Times, USA Today, CNN, MSNBC, Fox News, etc., and seemingly the entire blogosphere. The extensive media attention enabled Ryan's personal story of adoption, to reach millions. He is involved in national efforts to expose Planned Parenthood and defund the killing machine.
