## **JEWELS GREEN TO SPEAK AT PRO-LIFE DINNER ON APRIL 8**

Jewels Green was pressured into an abortion at age 17 and immediately spiraled into a deep depression. She attempted suicide and spent a month recovering in a psychiatric unit. After her hospital stay she masked her pain and anguish by staunchly supporting abortion rights. Jewels marched in support of abortion rights in Washington, DC just a handful of weeks after her traumatic abortion and suicide attempt then worked in an abortion clinic for 5 years of her young adulthood.

Since her change of heart, Jewels has been passionately devoted to the sacred cause of regaining legal protection for all human life at all stages of life. She will be signing copies of the book *We Choose Life: Authentic Stories – Movements of Hope* at the conclusion of the program. Her story is among those featured in the book.

West Virginians for Life President Dr. Wanda Franz will address the crowd as well as National Right to Life Political Director Karen Cross. A Silent Auction will also be a highlight.
